Supplementary to the Doctor of Medicine course rules is this document governing what constitutes satisfactory progress in the course and what rules are applied in cases of unsatisfactory progress:

Satisfactory progress – Supplement to the Doctor of Medicine (90850) and Doctor of Medicine (91850) Course Rules for 2024

For satisfactory progress in a calendar year a student must pass all units required for that year.

The marks used in determination of progress and assessment results are final marks after standard setting and moderation.

For students identified as having difficulties, these rules assume that appropriate support has been provided, and that reasonable adjustments to teaching, learning and assessment have been implemented if appropriate. Independent of the MD Course Rules, progression in the Course may also be affected according to UWA regulations on student conduct and discipline.

Decisions on unsatisfactory Professional Behaviour Assessments (PBAs) are based on the civil standard of proof.

When making decisions on progress and/or remediation related to PBA, the BoE considers these in the context of:

- a. the student's previous academic/professionalism conduct, and,
- b. the student's stage in the course, and capacity for remediation; and,
- c. the degree of incongruence in the behaviours documented, compared to the standards required for MBA Good Medical Practice.

The BoE can convene at any time to make a decision on student progress according to the PBA requirement.

The PBA requirement is assessed on an annual basis for the MD core units (IMED3111/3112, IMED4220/4222, IMED5311/5312, and IMED5411/5412.)
PBA findings from IMED3111 are carried forward into the BoE decisions for IMED3112. Accordingly, students with three or more upheld unsatisfactory Professionalism assessments across IMED3111 and/or IMED3112 will be considered to fail their PBA barrier for MD1.

PBA findings from the first part of a linked unit in MD2, 3 and 4 (i.e. IMED4220, 5311, and 5411) are carried forward into the BoE decisions for IMED4222, 5312, and 5412 respectively. Accordingly, students with three or more upheld unsatisfactory Professionalism assessments across the year will be considered to fail their PBA barrier for that year.

PBA is assessed on a unit basis for Scholarly Activity units. Students with three or more upheld unsatisfactory Professionalism assessments in a unit (for Scholarly Activity units) will be considered to fail their PBA barrier.

PBA is assessed on a unit basis for Elective and Preparation for Internship units. Students with a single upheld unsatisfactory Professionalism assessments in Elective or Preparation for Internship will be considered to fail their PBA barrier.

Students who fail any end of year or end of unit barrier will be discussed at the relevant Board of Examiners meeting, and the usual penalty applied at the Board of Examiners is to fail that year or unit.

Supplementary assessments will not be permitted for a student who:

- a. fails 2 or more units in a calendaryear; or:
- b. fails a deferred or supplementary assessment; or:
- c. has a progress status of 'On Probation'.

Students undertaking Scholarly Activity Coursework units will be bound by those respective unit rules. Students repeating a year or semester will be eligible for credit for Scholarly Activity units in that year or semester if the Scholarly Activity mark is 70% or above in those units. Despite credit being given for Scholarly Activity Research or Service Learning Units, students required to repeat a year will have continuation in these streams considered on a case-by-case basis according to ongoing availability of projects and supervisors. Students may be required to complete their credit point requirements by enrolling in Scholarly Activity – Coursework units.

Students repeating a year are required to participate in the mentoring and remediation program applicable to that year, including completion of assessments.

Submission of all items of written assessment, whether in-semester or end-of-semester, is a required component of each MD unit. Students must submit assessments completed as per task requirements and complete all clinical in-training assessments. Note that students with special consideration may have alternative assessment arrangements instituted. Students who fail to submit an assessment item completed as per task requirements will be issued with a SPAN (Structured Professional Assessment Note) by their discipline coordinator.

Details of SPAN and PBA processes are available in the MD Guidebook and MD Community LMS site.
